Free Disposal Day – Waste Management is sponsoring a free disposal day for Sept 7th for Orion residents at the Eagle Valley Recycling and Disposal Facility (must show ID). The event is from 7:00am to 1:00pm. Some materials will not be accepted such as e-waste (see no haz event), yard waste, liquids, tires, or items that contained Freon. No commercial construction debris is accepted.

No Haz Event – There are two upcoming no haz events to dispose of your household hazardous waste. This event is free to Orion Township residents. The types of items accepted are: Household paints, stains, expired medications, old propane cylinders, electronics, batteries, oil, gasoline, fluorescent lamps and more.
